## Call for new SIG8 Coordinator and new Junior Coordinator

We are looking for a next SIG 08 Coordinator and a new Junior Coordinator for the period from 2023-2027. The new coordinators will be nominated at the EARLI 2023 conference in August. The new SIG Coordinator will work together with the SIG Coordinator Hanna Gaspard in collaboration with the Junior Coordinators Juliane Schlesier and the new Junior Coordinator (to be nominated).

Key responsibilities of the SIG Coordinator include the coordination and organization of SIG activities (such as the International Conference on Motivation (ICM), newsletters and social media presence, see SIG 8 video). Moreover, the SIG Coordinators are the liaison between our SIG members, EARLI Executive Committee and EARLI office. Individuals who are nominated should have been a member of the SIG 08 for several years.

Key responsibilities of the SIG Junior Coordinator include the organization of "How to talk"- webinar, coordination of junior activities (e.g. in JURE conference and summer school) and actively representing SIG 8 in social media. We hope that our junior members will see this as a great opportunity to get involved in and influence our research community. The Junior Coordinator should be a JURE member at the start of their term. JURE (Junior Researchers of EARLI) includes graduate students as well as graduates who have received their doctorate within the last two years.

We hope that you will seriously consider applying for these positions, as it is a great way to contribute to our research community and to expand your professional network!
